EVENT NAME: Can You Sell It?

CLASSES: 6-8

EVENT MODE: LIVE

DESCRIPTION OF EVENT: Students have to come up with an innovative way to sell a scientific/technical product through jingles. (Example: beaker, test tube etc)

FORMAT:

- This is an individual based event.
- Inappropriate language can lead to negative markings.
- Reading from any kind of device or sheet is not allowed
- Time Limit 90 secs to 120 secs
- Students will be given various science related equipment and products which they will have to sell in innovative ways.
- Jingles, PPTs and other innovative ideas are encouraged.
- The students can choose any 1 of the following products to sell:
 - a. Mercury Thermometer
 - b. Test tube
 - c. Electronic weighing machine
 - d Solar inverter
 - e. Scientific calculator
 - f. Telescopes

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR EVENT DAY:

- The competition will be held online via Zoom App, therefore participants should make sure that the supporting equipment and devices are available (Laptop/PC with a functioning camera, speaker, microphone, and internet connection).
- All students participating should have their cameras turned on at all times.
- During the competition, the microphone of all the participants will be muted. Participants are only allowed to unmute the microphone when their name is called to start speaking.
- No student should use any kind of slur/foul/phobic language of any kind against anyone in the meeting or in general. Doing so guarantees instant expulsion from SAITED
- During the competitions, the registered participants cannot be represented by anyone else, otherwise they will be disqualified.

- Participants should rename themselves in the Zoom Meeting in the following format: (Name_Class_SchoolName) (e.g. RitaSingh_Class2_SAI)
- Participants are requested to preferably be in their respective school uniforms while attending the zoom meeting.
- Students are requested to have a plain setting as your background for the zoom meeting.
- All participants should respect and appreciate the judgement given by the judges.
- The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence pertaining to the judging process will be entertained.
- Every participant should be present at least 15 (fifteen) minutes before the competition starts. If the participant is not present when their names are called, he/she will be disqualified from the competition.
