EVENT NAME: Explore Your Imagination

CLASSES:

- \rightarrow Group 1 Classes (4-5)
- \rightarrow Group 2 Classes (6-8)
- \rightarrow Group 3 Classes (9-12)

EVENT MODE: Live

DESCRIPTION OF EVENT: This is a competition divided into 2 parts—

- 1. **What if ...?**: Participants will speak about what they would do if they were in an unpredictable scientific situation.
- 2. **If I were...** Participants will speak about what they would do if one morning they woke up and were a notable figure in science.

FORMAT:

Topics for Finals:

- Group 1 –Grade (4-5)
 - o 1. What if you can read the minds of animals?
 - o 2. If I were an insect
- Group 2 –Grade (6-8)
 - o 1. What if one day the moon disappears?
 - o 2. If I were a space scientist
- Group 3 –Grade (9-12)
 - o 1. What if you accidently wake up in the parallel universe?
 - 2. If I were a hybrid (Combination of 2 species, for example 'If I were a combination of a bird and a reptile')
- Students will have to speak on the given topics
- Each participant will get 1 min each to speak on both the topics given to them. The participants will start with the topic of 'What if' and then speak on 'If I were'.
- The participants will begin by introducing themselves. (Name, Class, School and Topic) The timer will start after introduction.
- Extra 10 seconds will be awarded to all participants. If the time limit exceeds this, marks will be reduced accordingly.
- In case there are any network issues, the participant will be given one chance in the end.
- Judges can disqualify any participants if they show any disrespectful behaviour against anyone in the competition.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR EVENT DAY:

- The competition will be held online via Zoom App, therefore participants should make sure that the supporting equipment and devices are available (Laptop/PC with a functioning camera, speaker, microphone, and internet connection).
- All students participating should have their cameras turned on at all times.
- During the competition, the microphone of all the participants will be muted. Participants are only allowed to unmute the microphone when their name is called to start speaking.
- No student should use any kind of slur/foul/phobic language of any kind against anyone in the meeting or in general. Doing so guarantees instant expulsion from SAITED
- During the competitions, the registered participants cannot be represented by anyone else, otherwise they will be disqualified.
- Participants should rename themselves in the Zoom Meeting in the following format: (Name_Class_SchoolName) (e.g. RitaSingh_Class2_SAI)
- Participants are requested to preferably be in their respective school uniforms while attending the zoom meeting.
- Students are requested to have a plain setting as your background for the zoom meeting.
- All participants should respect and appreciate the judgement given by the judges.
- The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence pertaining to the judging process will be entertained.
- Every participant should be present at least 15 (fifteen) minutes before the competition starts. If the participant is not present when their names are called, he/she will be disqualified from the competition.

- Content-(20 points)
- Fluency-(10 points)
- Creativity-(15 points)
- Vocabulary-(5 points)
