

EVENT DETAILS

EVENT NAME: Lost Science

CLASSES: 9-12

EVENT MODE: Live

DESCRIPTION OF EVENT: Participants are required to choose a scientist of their choice and refute their invention chronology. Here, they basically mention scientists overlooked by history.

FORMAT:

- Each participant has to choose a scientist who was overlooked by history and have to come prepared with a 3 minutes monologue.
- The monologue should include some details about the scientist, their invention and how they were overlooked. They could also add details on the impact on Science today if the scientist would have received the due recognition.
- The participants will be given a maximum of 3 minutes after which there will be a warning bell.
- Based on the cumulative scores achieved winners will be declared
- Judges have the right to disqualify participants if they exhibit any disrespectful behaviour against anyone involved in the event.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR EVENT DAY:

- The competition will be held online via Zoom App, therefore participants should make sure that the supporting equipment and devices are available (Laptop/PC with a functioning camera, speaker, microphone, and internet connection).
- All students participating should have their cameras turned on at all times.
- During the competition, the microphone of all the participants will be muted. Participants are only allowed to unmute the microphone when their name is called to start speaking.
- No student should use any kind of slur/foul/phobic language of any kind against anyone in the meeting or in general. Doing so guarantees instant expulsion from SAITED
- During the competitions, the registered participants cannot be represented by anyone else, otherwise they will be disqualified.
- Participants should rename themselves in the Zoom Meeting in the following format: (Name_Class_SchoolName) (e.g. RitaSingh_Class2_SAI)
- Participants are requested to preferably be in their respective school uniforms while attending the zoom meeting.
- Students are requested to have a plain setting as your background for the zoom meeting.
- All participants should respect and appreciate the judgement given by the judges.
